Key Operating Businesses

ASTRA Indonesia

Astra (50.1%), listed on the Jakarta and Surabaya stock exchanges, is a leading conglomerate in Indonesia and the largest independent automotive group in Southeast Asia.

Automotive

Astra is Indonesia's leading manufacturer, assembler, distributor, retailer and after-sales service provider of automobiles, motorcycles and automotive components. It holds 55% of the country's motor car market with marques such as Toyota, Daihatsu, Isuzu, Nissan Diesel, Peugeot and BMW, and 53% of the motorcycle market in Indonesia through Honda. It also manufactures and distributes automotive parts for both domestic and export markets.

Financial Services

Astra's financial services business comprises automotive and heavy equipment financing, banking, general insurance and life insurance. Its automotive division finances more than 73,000 new and used cars and more than 40% of Honda motorcycles in Indonesia while its heavy equipment financing covers the mining, construction, forestry and agriculture sectors.

Heavy Equipment

The group is the sole distributor of Komatsu construction machinery and mining equipment. It supplies mining, construction, forestry and agricultural equipment, heavy-duty trucks, cranes, forklifts and provides after-sales services. It is the largest mining services contractor in Indonesia.

Agribusiness

Astra's agribusiness includes the cultivation, harvesting and processing of palm oil and the group is one of the largest producers of crude palm oil in Indonesia, producing some one million tonnes of crude palm oil in 2006. Its 35 oil palm plantations cover some 200,000 hectares across the country. Astra also has interests in rubber.

IT and Infrastructure

Astra has other business interests in information technology ("IT") and infrastructure. It provides document and IT solutions and is the sole distributor for Fuji Xerox, providing hardware, rental distribution and after-sales services of office automation products. Astra's infrastructure activities include telecommunication, toll roads, water utilities and logistic transportation.

Singapore

Cycle & Carriage (100%) is one of the premier automotive groups in Singapore. It is engaged in motor vehicle retail and distribution and provision of after-sales services. The marques represented are Mercedes-Benz, Mitsubishi, Kia and Citroën.

Malaysia

Cycle & Carriage Bintang (59.1%) is listed on Bursa Malaysia and is principally involved in motor vehicle retail and distribution and provision of after-sales services, representing Mercedes-Benz, Mazda and Peugeot. It is also a dealer for Smart cars and Fuso commercial vehicles.

Indonesia

Tunas Ridean (37.4%) is listed on the Jakarta Stock Exchange and is the largest independent motor vehicle dealership group in Indonesia, representing Toyota, Daihatsu, BMW and Peugeot motor cars and Honda motorcycles. It is also a major provider of vehicle financing and rental and fleet management services across Indonesia.
