

FREDDY LEE – CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Mr Lee was appointed Chief Executive Officer on 1st May 2026.

He leads JC&C's portfolio and capital strategies, and has direct oversight over of the portfolio businesses. He is an Executive Director and was last re-elected as a Director on 30th April 2026. He is also a commissioner of Astra and the Chairman of REE. He was previously the Group Finance Director of JC&C from June 2025 to April 2026.

He joined the Jardine Matheson group in 2012 and has held several senior leadership roles including Finance Director and Business Development Director of Astra WeLab Digital Arta, Group Managing Director of Innovix Distribution, and Managing Director Southeast Asia of JTH Holdings. He was also the Chief Risk and Audit Officer at Astra from 2022 to 2025.

Before joining Jardines, Mr Lee held corporate finance, investment and business development roles in multinational companies across various industries.

He is a CFA charterholder and a former Temasek scholarship recipient. Mr Lee graduated from the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign with a Master of Science.

NG YANG YEN – FINANCE DIRECTOR

Mr Ng was appointed Finance Director and Executive Director on 1st May 2026.

As Finance Director, Mr Ng oversees the accounting, finance, treasury and tax functions of the Group.

Mr Ng joined JC&C in 2006, and was previously General Manager, Group Finance from 2020 to 2026. He has over 20 years institutional knowledge of the Group, with a track record of disciplined financial stewardship across cycles.

Before joining JC&C, Mr Ng was a senior associate at KPMG.

Mr Ng is a member of the Institute of Singapore Chartered Accountants and graduated from Nanyang Technological University Singapore with a Bachelor of Accountancy.

CHEAH KIM TECK – DIRECTOR, BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

Mr Cheah is Director, Business Development since January 2014. He is responsible for overseeing the Group's investment in THACO and developing new lines of business for the Group in the region.

Prior to that, he was Chief Executive Officer of the Group's motor operations in Singapore, and in that capacity, he also held oversight of JC&C's other automotive businesses in Malaysia, Myanmar, Vietnam and Indonesia excluding those held by Astra, until he stepped down from his position in 2013. Mr Cheah also served on the Board of JC&C from 2005 until he retired as director in 2014. He is a director of THACO and Mapletree Investments, and the non-executive chairman of Mapletree Industrial Trust Management, the manager of SGX-listed Mapletree Industrial Trust.

Prior to joining the Group, he held several senior marketing positions in multinational companies, namely, McDonald's Restaurant, Kentucky Fried Chicken and Coca-Cola. Mr Cheah was conferred The Public Service Star and The Public Service Medal by the President of Singapore in 2016 and 2012 respectively, for his distinguished achievements and valuable public service.
